RED

Chateau Du Pin Bordeaux

60% Merlot, 40% Cabernet, this wine blackish red in color with notes of black cherry, blueberry, oak and mocha.

Altosur Malbec, Argentina

Attractive red color with violet hues. Aromas of intense ripe fruit: cherries, blackberries, blueberries, and fresh plums, combined with spicy and floral hints. One of good intensity and long after taste.

Angeline Pinot Noir, California

Bright fruit flavors of fresh strawberry, cherry, raspberry and ripe plum are layered with creamy vanilla, earthy overtones, tea spice and sweet toasty oak on the finish.

La Fiera Pinot Grigio, Italy

A delightfully fresh and crisp wine. It is both floral and fruity, expressing ripe peach and apple flavors with a subtle mineral finish.

Centorri Moscato

This wine is rich and round with lively mandarin and cantaloupe aromas. Flavors of melon mixed with exotic tropical fruits like mango, papaya, and star fruit

Aromas of pears, apples and tropical nuances with subtle notes of butter. On the entry, pear and green apple flavors are framed by nice acidity which integrates well with the medium body mouth feel.
